GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2014, Decision was rendered in the above-entitled case, the dispositive part of which reads:

"WHEREFORE, all the foregoing premises being considered, judgment is hereby rendered ordering the respondents to pay jointly and solidarily the complainant the awards, as follows: US\$8,240.00 as salaries for the unexpired portion of the employment contract; P50,000.00 as moral damages; P25,000.00 as exemplary damages; and ten percent of the total judgment award as and for attorney's fees.

SO ORDERED."

WHEREAS, respondent did not appeal the assailed decision failed to do so to the Commission, thus the decision became final and executory on April 13, 2015 pursuant to Rule V, Section 19 of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure.

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2015, Galo Regino L. Esperanza, Labor Arbitration Associate issued a Certificate of Finality;

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2015, complainant through counsel filed a Motion for Execution;

WHEREAS, the case was set for pre-execution conference on June 11, 2015, both parties failed to appear.

WHEREAS, another pre-execution conference was reset on June 18, 2015, only complainant and his counsel appeared. No appearance from the respondents.

Complainant moved for the issuance of the writ of execution against the respondents.

NOW, THEREFORE, you are hereby commanded to collect, in accordance with Section 10, Rule XVI of the Omnibus Rules and Regulations Implementing the Migrant Workers and Overseas Filipinos Act of 1995 (Republic Act No. 8042), as amended by Republic Act No. 1022, the total amount of **FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY TWO PESOS (Php482,222.40)** from respondents **MY International Manpower Corporation and/or Tee-Yan Employment Agency, Law Lay Hong, and Heidi D. Asuncion** whose address on record is at Door 2 Iloilo Asian Lumber and Hardware Inc. # 144 M.H. del Pilar Street, Molo, Iloilo City or wherever they may be found representing complainant's judgment award inclusive of ten (10%) percent as for attorney's fees and moral and exemplary damages pursuant to the Decision dated **December 12, 2014**.

Further collect from the respondent the execution fee in the amount of **P4,322.22** and deposit fee of **P1,836.90** pursuant to the Manual on Execution. Respondents **MY International Manpower Corporation and/or Tee-Yan Employment Agency, Law Lay Hong, and Heidi D. Asuncion** are directed to pay the total judgment award including the necessary fees within thirty (30) days from receipt of this writ.

In case you fail to collect the amounts above-mentioned within the said thirty (30) days, or the amount collected is insufficient to satisfy the judgment award, you are hereby ordered to cause the satisfaction of the judgment award against the performance bond or escrow deposit of the respondent with the POEA. If the same is deficient, the judgment award shall be enforced in accordance with Section 9 (a), Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended.
