



INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT COURIER SERVICES FY 2022

1. The **National Labor Relations Commission**, through the **National Expenditure Program FY2022** intends to apply the sum of **Eleven Million, Seven Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Pesos (Php 11,739,000.00)** being the ABC to payments under the contract for the Procurement of Courier Services FY 2022 [PB2022-01-03]. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The **National Labor Relations Commission** now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required by **January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022**. Bidders should have completed, within **5 (five) years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "**pass/fail**" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the **National Labor Relations Commission** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8am to 4pm, Mondays to Fridays, except holidays**.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **September 29, 2021** from the given address and websites below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Php 10,000.00**. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees **in person and through electronic means**.



6. The **National Labor Relations Commission** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **October 7, 2021 at 10am** through video conferencing or webcasting **via Zoom or other similar application/technology**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through the following means: **(i) manual submission** at the office address indicated below, and **(ii) online or electronic submission** as indicated below on or before **October 19, 2021 at 1pm**. Late bids shall not be accepted.
 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 14**.
 9. Bid opening shall be on **October 20, 2021 at 10am** at the given address below and through video conferencing or webcasting **via Zoom or other similar application/technology**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
 10. *With respect to the documentary requirements, the Committee shall any accept the following:*
 - a. **Original or certified true copies** duly certified by the issuing agency; or
 - b. **Photocopies subject to verification** with the original during the opening of the bids.
 11. The **National Labor Relations Commission** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF BIDDING
SERVICES FY 2022

The Department of Education (DepEd) Division Office - Marikina City (DDO-MC) is seeking a qualified bidder to provide bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2022. The bidder must be a duly registered and licensed professional bidder in the Philippines.

The bidder must have a minimum net worth of at least P1,000,000.00 and must have a minimum net income of at least P100,000.00 for the last three (3) years immediately preceding the date of submission of the bid.

The bidder must have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2022. The bidder must also have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2021.

The bidder must have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2020. The bidder must also have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2019.

The bidder must have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2018. The bidder must also have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2017.

The bidder must have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2016. The bidder must also have a minimum experience of at least three (3) years in providing bidding services for the procurement of goods and services for the fiscal year 2015.
